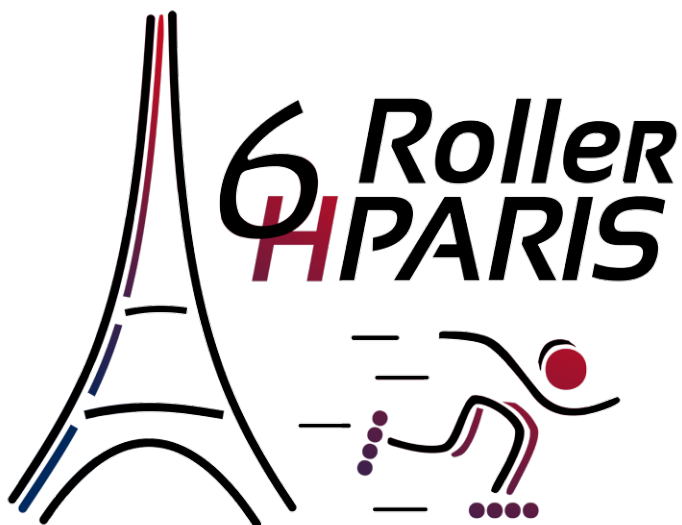

Les 6h de Paris

The 6h Roller Race in Paris is the biggest endurance race in Paris. It is of the 3rd largest roller skating race in France in terms of participants and it touches a wide public from beginners to national athletes to bring together all fans of roller skating for a summer afternoon.

The principle is simple: to achieve the greatest number of circuit laps for 6 hours, in teams of 2 to 5 skaters or solo. On Sunday, August 1st, 2021, the competition will take place for the 8th time in the Bois de Boulogne, from 11am to 5pm.

The race is also animated by free initiations to roller skating and by many other sports activities offered throughout the day in the roller-blading village. You can also test your pure speed on the SEBA Sprint Race, a 60m stop start race accessible all day. This free animation is open to everyone and great gifts can be won!

The race is open to everyone!

The 6h Roller de Paris are for children from 12 years and adults, whether they are beginners to discover this sport or experienced skaters. The race is also open to people with reduced mobility, with the participation of teams from the association Mobile en Ville» or British or Belgian teams. In total, there are more than 700 French and foreign skaters in more than 270 teams which are expected to participate in this new edition, supervised by a hundred volunteers, numerous spectators and coaches for a total of several thousand participants at the race venue on D-Day.

Distance travelled by each team results in rankings and rewards in 10 categories ranging from individual skaters to teams of five, including teams of veterans, handisport or quads. The record of the event is 214.7km (established in 2017 by the ROLLERBLADE World Team), and in total, the distance covered cumulatively by all participants exceeds 30,000 kilometres.

The organizer of the race: I Skate Paris

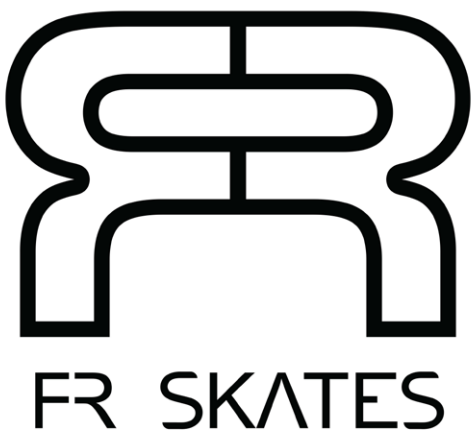
